

Integrated Dually Diagnosed Treatment (IDDT) Implementation Steering Committee

Purpose

To provide direction and oversight in the implementation of the IDDT model.

Structure

The Committee may consist of the following members:

Provider agency CEO or COO, Clinical Director, SAMI Team Leader/Supervisor, direct service representative, Quality Improvement Manager, County Board Representative(s), Consumer(s), Family member(s), and others in the community important to successful implementation. A committee chair may be appointed by designation or a consensually agreed upon process.

Meetings

Meetings will be chaired by the agency and held with sufficient frequency as to support implementation and maintenance of practice. Meeting minutes will be recorded and distributed to Committee Members. Committee members are strongly encouraged to attend all meetings.

Responsibilities

1. To develop a strategy and process of implementing the IDDT model.
2. To assure coordination of IDDT services between team and ancillary services providers.
3. To identify areas and select tools to standardize processes affecting the identification of patients in need of IDDT services.
4. Review and analyze treatment needs and recommend appropriate changes in the provision and delivery of IDDT services and programs.
5. To recommend and support training programs as needed to enhance and sustain the skills of employees providing IDDT services.
6. To coordinate planning and implementation with the state wide Regional Committee.
7. To review the IDDT Fidelity Scale and provide support for high level fidelity compliance.
8. To support innovative IDT initiatives in order to provide a more comprehensive treatment model.
9. To recognize and communicate the accomplishments of programs and employees providing services to IDDT patients.
